






















Artifact: An object, made by humans, that can help us understand what life was like at a certain time.

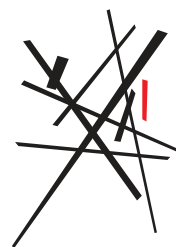
Collection: A purposeful group of objects that have certain characteristic(s) in common
